Primary Duties:

- Conduct regular preventative maintenance checks on Forklifts & Trucks during service, such as tyre condition & lift chain checks
- Help maintain parts inventory & workshop cleanliness
- Work in a team environment
- Work collaboratively with the team to diagnose problems & plan repairs
- Ensure all routine Quality Control (QC) checks are performed
- Supervision of staff, ensuring that they are abiding by the OH&S, and quality systems
- Keep a log / record of all scheduled services and breakdowns
- Ensure staff adhere to the site OH&S and quality policies and procedures
- Reporting any faults or damage directly to the Workshop Supervisor
- Ensure full compliance at all times to any procedures, instruction and other training which has been provided
- Maintain the workshop environment to a high standard

- Demonstrated experience working with heavy plant or forklift equipment
- Strong fault finding diagnostic skill both mechanical & electrical
