



## **Green Mill Production Cleaner**

Australian Sustainable Hardwoods (ASH) is a privately owned advanced timber manufacturer located in Heyfield employing over 200 people. The company operates two facilities in Heyfield and currently has a vacancy for an afternoon shift cleaner.

The position is a permanent, full-time role based onsite at the Green Mill (Firebrace Road).

The role involves cleaning the mill machines and surrounding areas from one end to the other completing a different area each night.

Duties involve but are not limited to:

- With the use of an air hose blowing down debris to the floor then picking it up and removing it to the correct waste bin.
- Cleaning out sawpits of sawdust build up using shovels and brooms into wheelbarrows and putting it in the correct waste bins.
- Basic yard cleaning, fixing bearers and the removal of old broken pieces of timber.
- Whipper snipping and weed spraying grounds when required.
- Other ad hoc duties as required

We are looking for a responsible dedicated person in good physical health that is willing to work to a schedule and unsupervised. To be successful within this role you will need to possess the following attributes:

- Be able to follow basic instructions given daily by the Supervisor or Manager
- Have the drive to get the required areas cleaned in a timely manner and to a satisfactory level
- Reliability is essential as this is a team of two people.
- Be able to work unsupervised as well as working within a team
- Be committed to helping maintain a safe workplace and be able to follow lock out procedures

The position is full time working across a 9-day fortnight:

- 12.30pm to 9.30pm Monday to Thursday.
- 12.30pm to 9pm one Friday; the alternative Friday is typically a non-working day.

Commencement pay for this role is a Level 4 plus 11.75% superannuation contributions along with the relevant shift allowance.
