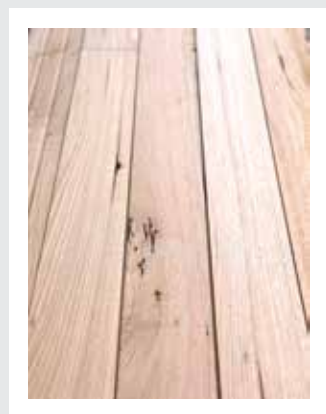


Why Classic Grade?

What is Australian Oak and IronAsh?

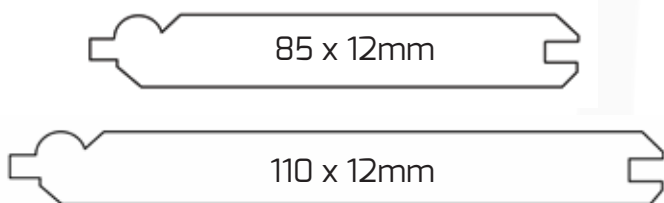
Australian Oak is Australian Sustainable Hardwoods brand of Tasmanian Oak timber made up of three species - Eucalyptus Regnans, Eucalyptus Delegatensis and Eucalyptus obliqua.

IronAsh is Australian Oak with the addition of a H3 water-based, durable treatment allowing it to be used in external applications. The treatment does not affect the colour of the timber and comes with a 25-year guarantee.

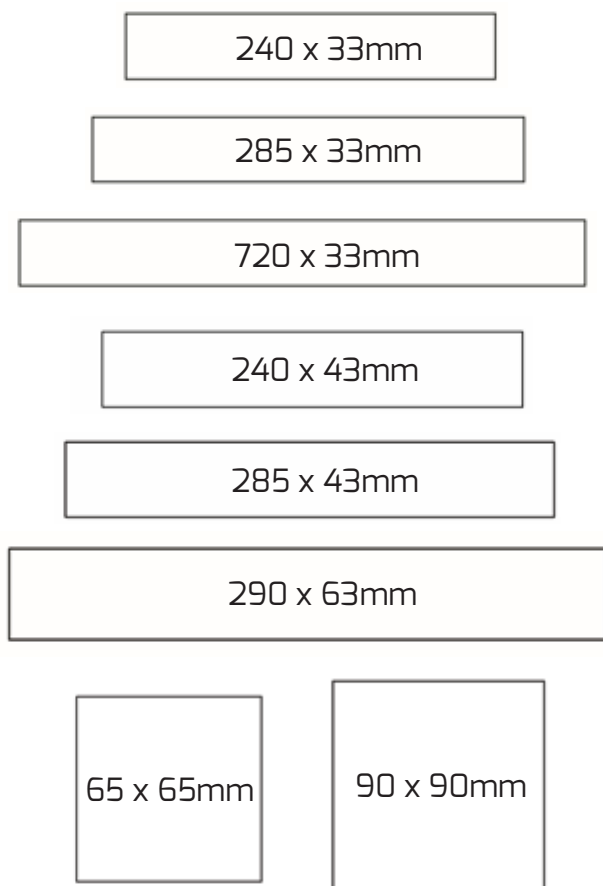

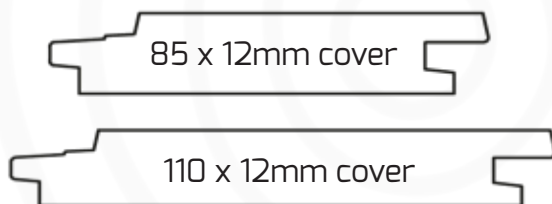

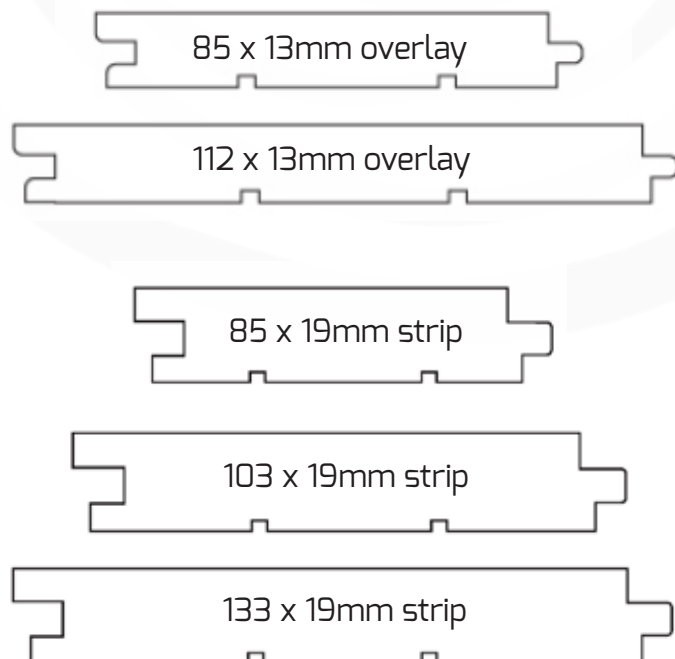

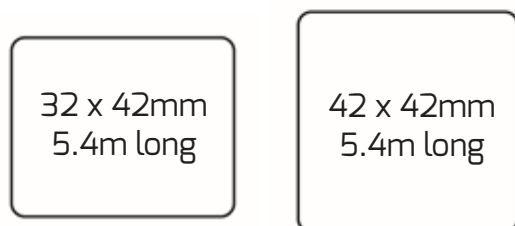

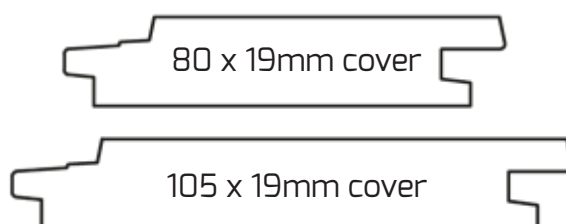

Download Classic Grade Guidelines

Characteristics to be expected in Classic Grade include (but not limited to), gum veins (tight and loose), gum pockets, hit and miss, knots, burls, pinholes, end splits and checks (surface and internal).
