



Mechanical Fitter Position

The role supports the maintenance team with site maintenance, machine breakdown repair, preventative maintenance, and continuous improvement of all site production assets and machinery including the fabrication and installation of new plant and equipment.

The successful applicant for this position will need to demonstrate the following skills and attributes.

Must be/have:

- Qualified machine fitter certification.
- Fabrication and welding skills.
- Ability to complete basic work output using a lathe and milling machine.
- A solid understanding of mechanical systems.
- Hydraulic and pneumatic fitting would be an advantage but not essential.
- Current forklift licence, and EWP licence would be an advantage.
- Previous exposure to timber processing plant an advantage but not essential.
- Reliable, with the ability to work unsupervised.
- Motivated and show initiative.
- Weekend and after-hours work will be required from time-to-time.

- Have a strong focus on health and safety.
- Ensure work is carried out within ASH's OH&S guidelines and policies.
- Ensure good workplace hygiene is maintained.

The hours of work are 76 hours over a 9-day fortnight with additional overtime.
